We have regularly met on the first Monday of the month for talks and practical experience. We have visited many of the major archaeological sites in Southern England, and have had organised extended visits to Dartmoor, Northumberland and Ireland. We have been involved with excavations in Potterspury, Wootton, Moulsoe and Fenny Lock, and we have done a great deal of field walking in the Stoke Goldington and Gayhurst areas. We have also carried out a resistivity survey and excavations at Tickford Priory in Newport Pagnell.

SOCIETY OBJECTIVES

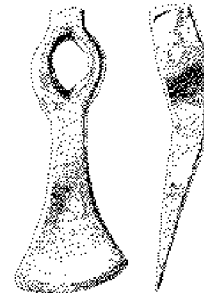
